

REPORT TO THE CITY COUNCIL FROM  
THE PUBLIC SAFETY, CIVIL RIGHTS & EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE  
STANDING COMMITTEE OF THE MINNEAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL  
September 16, 2015

A regular meeting of the committee was convened at 1:34 p.m. on this date.

Members Present: Council Members Blong Yang (Chair), Cam Gordon, Barbara Johnson, Abdi Warsame and Linea Palmisano (Quorum 4)

Members Absent: Council Member Kevin Reich

On motion by Yang, carried on voice vote, the agenda was amended to include a presentation on public safety in the downtown, item #10.

Matters listed below are hereby submitted with the following recommendations; to-wit:

1. Emergency service fees for technical rescue responses ordinance (15-00989)

Considering passage of ordinance amending Title 9, Chapter 173 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances relating to Fire and Police Protection: Fire, adding a new section 173.220, establishing fees for certain emergency protection services within the City.

Staff presentation by Joel Fussy, Assistant City Attorney and Fire Chief John Fruetel.

The public hearing was opened. There being no persons wishing to speak, the public hearing was closed.

On motion by B. Johnson, carried on voice vote, the matter was approved.

2. 2015 Emergency Management Performance grant (15-01159)

Accepting the 2015 Emergency Management Performance grant award in the amount of \$30,000 from the Minnesota Department of Public Safety/Homeland Security and Emergency Management, and approving the appropriation of funds into the Office of Emergency Management budget (**Refer to W&M**).

On motion by Yang, carried on voice vote, the matter was approved and referred to the Ways & Means Committee.

3. Minnesota Board of Firefighter Training and Education (MBFTE) training reimbursement redistribution (15-01160)

Accepting MBFTE redistribution funding under the Round 7 training reimbursement program in the amount of \$36,177.36 for MBFTE approved training conducted between July 1, 2014 and June 30, 2015; and Passage of Resolution approving appropriation of funds (**Refer to W&M**).

On motion by Yang, carried on voice vote, the matter was approved and referred to the Ways & Means Committee.

4. Minnesota GI Bill On-The-Job Training (OJT)/Apprenticeship Program funds (15-01161)

Accepting a \$23,000 initial hire payment from the State of Minnesota GI Bill OJT/Apprenticeship Program to cover 23 veteran hires at \$1,000 per hire; and Passage of Resolution approving appropriation of funds (**Refer to W&M**).

On motion by Yang, carried on voice vote, the matter was approved and referred to the Ways & Means Committee.

5. Zero Towards Deaths traffic enforcement partnership program grant ([15-01162](#))

Accepting grant of \$ 309,750 for the continuation of the MPD traffic enforcement partnership program for the year of October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2016, and entering into agreements to share the awarded funds with the University of Minnesota, Golden Valley, Crystal, Hopkins, Robbinsdale and New Hope in amounts to be determined.

On motion by Yang, carried on voice vote, the matter was approved.

6. Minnesota Department of Commerce contract amendment ([15-01163](#))

Authorizing an increase to Contract C-39469 with the Minnesota Department of Commerce of \$2,395.20 for a not-to-exceed total of \$4,895.20, using the MN Department of Commerce contract amendment form for the reimbursement of overtime for the work performed by the police officer on a fraud detail; and Passage of Resolution approving appropriation of funds (**Refer to W&M**).

On motion by Yang, carried on voice vote, the matter was approved and referred to the Ways & Means Committee.

7. Minnesota Bureau of Criminal Apprehension contract amendment ([15-01164](#))

Authorizing an increase to Contract C-36219 with the Minnesota Bureau of Criminal Apprehension (BCA) of \$6,000 for a not-to-exceed total of \$686,000, using the MN BCA contract amendment form for the analysis of MPD DNA case evidence.

On motion by Yang, carried on voice vote, the matter was approved.

8. Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention (OJJDP) grant application ([15-01165](#))

Approving the submission of a grant application of \$100,000 to the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention (OJJDP) for a new Program Coordinator position as part of the National Initiative for Building Community Trust and Justice program (**Refer to W&M**).

On motion by Yang, carried on voice vote, the matter was approved and referred to the Ways & Means Committee.
