

REPORT TO THE CITY COUNCIL FROM
THE PUBLIC SAFETY, CIVIL RIGHTS & EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE
STANDING COMMITTEE OF THE MINNEAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL
September 28, 2016

A regular meeting of the committee was convened at 1:30 p.m. on this date.

Matters listed below are hereby submitted with the following recommendations; to-wit:

1. Minnesota Board of Firefighter Training and Education Training (MBFTE) reimbursement ([16-01339](#))
 1. Accepting Minnesota Board of Firefighter Training and Education Training (MBFTE) funding under the Round 9 training reimbursement program in the amount of \$82,400, plus redistribution funding under the Round 8 training reimbursement program in the amount of \$15.91, for MBFTE approved training conducted between July 1, 2016 and June 30, 2017.
 2. Passage of Resolution approving appropriation to the Fire Department (**Refer to WM**).

On motion by Yang, carried on voice vote, the matter was approved and referred to the Ways & Means Committee.

2. Minnesota GI Bill On-The-Job Training (OJT)/Apprenticeship Program Employer payments ([16-01340](#))
 1. Accepting up to \$80,000 annually from the State of Minnesota GI Bill OJT/Apprenticeship Program to cover Veteran hires at \$1,000 per hire plus another \$1,000 for Veterans who have 12 consecutive months of employment.
 2. Passage of Resolution approving appropriation to the Fire Department (**Refer to WM**).

On motion by Yang, carried on voice vote, the matter was approved and referred to the Ways & Means Committee.

3. Joint Powers Agreement amendment with Minnesota Homeland Security and Emergency Management for state bomb disposal unit response ([16-01341](#))

Authorizing an increase to contract C-40510 with the Minnesota Homeland Security and Emergency Management of \$50,000, for a not-to-exceed total of \$77,000, and an extension through June 30, 2018, using the Minnesota Homeland Security and Emergency Management contract amendment form for out-state Police Bomb Disposal Unit response (**Refer to WM**).

On motion by Yang, carried on voice vote, the matter was approved and referred to the Ways & Means Committee.

4. Contract with Regents of the University of Minnesota – Medical Center for 2016-2017 for veterinary services for the Police K-9's ([16-01342](#))

Authorizing a contract with Regents of the University of Minnesota – Medical Center for veterinary services for the Police K-9's, for \$30,525 from July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017, using the University of Minnesota contract form (**Refer to WM**).

On motion by Yang, carried on voice vote, the matter was approved and referred to the Ways & Means Committee.

5. Complaint Filing Experience Report of the Police Conduct Oversight Commission (PCOC) ([16-01343](#))
 1. Receiving the *Complaint Filing Experience* Report of the PCOC.
 2. Directing staff from the Civil Rights Department Office of Police Conduct Review to work with the Police Department staff to review the Commission's recommendations and report back to the Public Safety, Civil Rights and Emergency Management Committee on process improvements by March 31, 2017.

The Chair afforded the courtesy of the floor to Jennifer Singleton, Vice Chair of the Police Conduct Oversight Commission, who presented the report, along with Police Commander Jason Case, Internal Affairs Unit.

On motion by Gordon, carried by voice vote, staff from the Civil Rights Department Office of Police Conduct Review was directed to work with the Police Department staff to review the Commission's recommendations and report back to the Public Safety, Civil Rights and Emergency Management Committee on process improvements by March 31, 2017.

On motion by Yang, carried on voice vote, the matter was received and filed.

With no further business to transact, the meeting adjourned at 2:12 p.m.
