- Chaired Bryn Mawr Neighborhood Association Land Use Committee that wrote, with assistance of a Humphrey Institute graduate student, the Bryn Mawr Land Use Plan. Plan approved as a small area plan by the Minneapolis City Council in 2003
- Member of Bassett Creek Valley Redevelopment Oversight Committee which wrote 2 master plans for the Bassett Creek Valley, with assistance from consulting firms – Master Plan 2000 and Master Land Use Plan 2006. The 2006 plan has been incorporated into the City of Minneapolis' Comprehensive Plan. Rezoning of the Bassett Creek Valley to reflect the land uses in the 2006 Master Plan has been completed.

3. Co-Wrote grant for funds for buckthorn removal at Brownie Lake, Bassett's Creek at Fruen Mill (multiple grants and projects), on private land (people's homes).
4. Worked with NRP, Hennepin County, the City and Bryn Mawr Neighborhood Association to redesign/beautify the Penn Avenue/South Cedar Lake Road Intersection.
