On February 17, 2012, a notice of tax liability was issued by the Minnesota Department of Revenue to revoke the pet shop license of Pandora's Box Veterinary Clinic. Minn. Stat. 270C.72, 16D.08, 349A.06, 349.155 or 349.155 subd 3 requires the City of Minneapolis to revoke their business license within 30 days of receiving this notice until a tax clearance notice is received. This is authorized under Minneapolis Code of Ordinances 259.15.
