Acceptance of the single bid of Intex for an estimated expenditure of \$272,580.00 to furnish and deliver all labor, materials and incidentals necessary to crush concrete curb and gutter, sidewalk slabs, driveway slabs and rubble asphalt for the City of Minneapolis Public Works Department, as follows:



RE: OP8021 Crushing Concrete

On October 30, 2014 bids were open for this official publication for crushing concrete, and there was one bidder, Intex. I have reviewed the past 14 years of bid results for crushing concrete and have included this tabulation in this memorandum to you. The bidder Intex has bid the 2015 work two percent higher than their 2012 bids (two years ago) and commit to these prices for the next four years.

Based on my review, I believe that this bid is fair and reasonable. I therefore recommend award of this bid to Intex for crushing rubble concrete for the City of Minneapolis Public Works.
