Dear Mr. Kotke:

The City of Minneapolis as part of the Management Agreement 66310, manages major maintenance improvement projects on behalf of Mn/DOT for the ABC Ramps (TAD Garages). Management of these projects includes obtaining contracts with appropriate vendors through the standard City of Minneapolis procurement process to perform all needed services and equipment purchases.

In 2009-2010 there are several major maintenance improvement projects. The funding for these projects is secured through a combination of sources including Transportation Revolving Loan Funds (TRLF) administered through the Public Facilities Authority (PFA), a Lease-Purchase through the Department of Finance and available funds in Mn/DOT's ABC Ramps Major Maintenance account. Mn/DOT will reimburse the City of Minneapolis upon receipt of invoices through the established Request For Funds (RFF) process outlined in Amendment No. 1 of the Management Agreement 66310.

The Mn/DOT has approved this budget and acquired funding for the following:
