David, per your request I am sending to you the additional information for my recommendation for the acceptance the bid for the security fence.

I recommend the acceptance of the reduced bid by Midwest Fence and MFG., Co, in the amount of \$775,935.00 for the construction of the security fence at Hilltop.

Midwest Fence has been the only bidder on this project and submitted the bid in the amount of \$827,460.00.

After the careful review the Midwest Fence revised the bid and reduced the price by \$51,525. Some changes have been to simplify the design and following reduction in labor and material, that were approved by the City.

Funding of \$1 Million is in place and available from 7400-950-9515, Job #C5297080. Therefore the bid amount of \$775,935.00 is within the budget.
