Under the 2009 American Recovery and Reinvestment Act, the City of Minneapolis will be eligible to receive \$5,520,902 in Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-

**Housing Program (HPRP) funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. In order to make application for funding, the City will need to amend its 2008 Consolidated Plan. HUD is requiring a 12-day public comment period prior to the May 18, 2009 application deadline. The City will have this comment period April 17-28. The comment period will conclude with a public hearing before the Community Development Committee, who will also take up consideration of the draft Consolidated Plan Amendment.**
