3. Increase the 2009 Operating Budget appropriations for the following agencies:
  - Community Planning and Economic Development Business Development by \$781,960
  - Community Planning and Economic Development Business Finance by \$ 817,447
  - Public Works Property Services by \$ 2,212,393
  - Coordinator Sustainability by \$ 98,000
