**Subject: Request for Permission to Accept a DWI Court Grant Amendment from the Fourth Judicial District Court**

**Recommendation:** That the proper officials be authorized to execute an amendment with the Fourth Judicial District Court for a portion of the implementation of an Adult DWI Court in Hennepin County to fund wages for police officers to participate in this new program. The grant award amendment to Minneapolis is \$20,000. The Department requests an amendment to the general appropriation resolution for 2008 in the amount of \$20,000. The grant award will operate through the state grant fund, 01600-4002735-321503.

### Supporting Information

The Minnesota Department of Public Safety awarded the Fourth Judicial District Court a grant for the implementation of an Adult DWI Court in Hennepin County. The City previously accepted \$17, 748 in grant funds for DWI Court. The MPD is now offered an additional \$20,000, for a total of \$37,748.

A portion of the grant will fund overtime wages and benefits for a police officer to participate in the program. Participation will include team meetings and home visits. \$37,748 of the grant is set aside to fund the participation of a Minneapolis Officer in the program.
