The Minneapolis Police Department has participated in the Weed & Seed Federal grant program for several years, including an award for 2008. Due to the city-wide moratorium on additional security cameras, the Central Weed and Seed Steering Committee has modified its budget and Workplan and decreased the budget to the Police Department by \$18,280.
