
**Recommendation:**

2. to increase both the revenue estimate in fund/department 01600-8600152 (revenue code 322002) and the 2011 appropriation in fund/department 01600-8600152 by \$60,000.

**Background/Supporting Information Attached**

The Department's School Based Clinic program has received funding for three years from the Children's Mental Health Collaborative of Hennepin County to provide mental health services to Latino students served through the School Based Clinic program. This amendment provides funding to extend the project an additional two years. The licensed therapist works half time offering individual and group counseling services to Latino students and their families at Roosevelt High School.
