## Job Seeker Programs:

If you are unemployed or underemployed, you may be eligible for employment and training services from a trained career counselor through one of these programs:

- **Minneapolis Works (MW):** Provides low-income, Minneapolis job seekers ages 18 or older with personalized career guidance, skills training, and job search services.
- **Dislocated Worker Program (DW):** Comprehensive career counseling services for individuals who have lost their job through no fault of their own for adults ages 18 or older.
- **WIOA Adult Program (WA):** Individualized career counseling services for adults looking to improve, update, or gain new employment skills.
- **Minneapolis Youth Works (YW):** Helps youth and young adults learn academic, life and work skills, identify career paths, and achieve meaningful employment.
- **STEP-UP:** Prepares Minneapolis youth, ages 14-21, for future employment by offering training and paid summer work experience at Minneapolis businesses.
