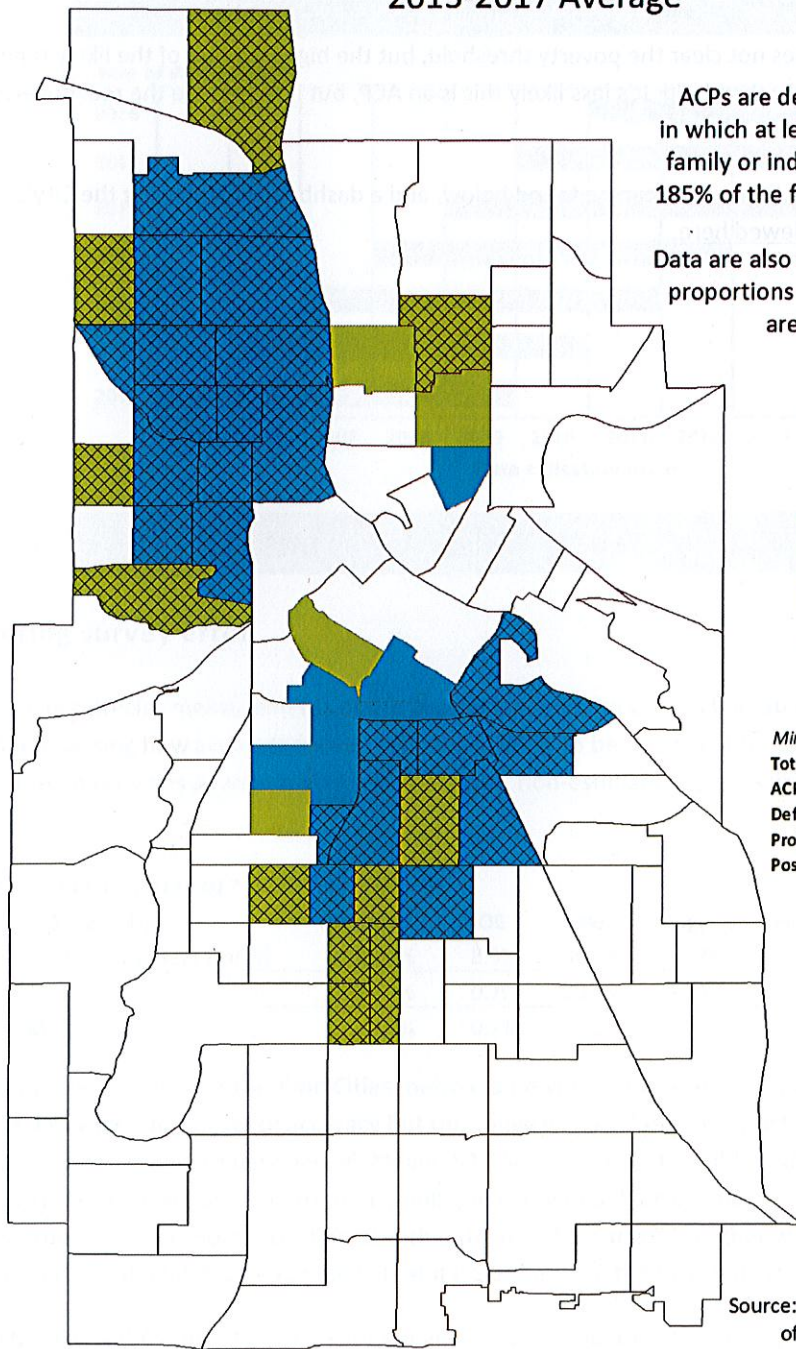


Areas of Concentrated Poverty (ACP) 2013-2017 Average

ACPs are defined as a Census tract in which at least 40% of residents with family or individual income are below 185% of the federal poverty threshold.

Data are also controlled to remove high proportions of college students who are not in poverty.
