- 1) Verbal comment by City at pre-bid meeting – will clarify categories of 2105.505 MUCK EXCAVATION on bid form.

RESPONSE: Bid form has been updated (see next page) as follows:

For Site 1, material is suitable for Level 1 Residential fill, but must be disposed of off-site due to lack of space on-site.

For Sites 2 and 3, material is not suitable as unregulated fill. Material is to be disposed of in an appropriately permitted landfill.

- 2) Written question by Veit after pre-bid meeting – On the bid form, you have items listed with – Estimated Quantities. Are we to provide unit prices for these items?

RESPONSE: Bid form has been updated, see item 1) above. Line 3 is an item listed with 0 Estimated Quantity. Yes, the Bidder is to provide a unit price for this item.

Purpose: As note in the Technical Memorandum for Site 1 (on pages 69 and 72 of 304 in the Bid Packet), the samples collected demonstrate that concentrations of potential contaminants in sediment are less than the MPCA Tier 1 and Tier 2 Soil Reference Values, indicating the material would be suitable for re-use on properties of any land use category (Level 1). As noted in Division S Special Provisions and General Requirements (on page 57 of 304 in the Bid Packet), if during the excavation, areas of suspected contamination are encountered, the Contractor shall follow procedures in S18.B Unknown Contaminated Materials (on page 59 or 304 in the Bid Packet). In the event that the procedures in S18.B necessitate disposal of A PORTION of the materials as REGULATED FILL at an appropriately permitted landfill, the unit price for Line 3 will apply for THE PORTION (only) of the excavated materials meeting MPCA regulated fill contaminated soil characterization.
