Background and Project:

Internship opportunity is available with the Minneapolis Health Department (MHD) for a Teen Health Peer Education Group Facilitator. This is a paid internship for up to 8 hours/week that requires the student to collaborate with the Minneapolis Health Department (MHD) School Based Clinic Staff.

The Minneapolis School Based Clinics are a Minneapolis Health Department program that partners with the Minneapolis Public Schools. School based clinics provide high quality, affordable, and comprehensive medical and behavioral health services by professional staff specializing in adolescent health.

Facilitator Projects:

- With a clinic provider, co-facilitate a health-focused peer education group at Southwest High School according to existing facilitation materials while additionally creating new materials
- Recruit members through outreach events, posters, social media, and other media
- Plan & co-facilitate meetings using a peer-driven leadership model for peer education
- Help students plan outreach projects
- Use program evaluations and implement changes according to feedback
- Develop relationships with teachers and administration

Time commitment & work days: The facilitator will work 8 hours per week, on Thursdays from 9am to 5pm. Meetings occur Thursdays at Southwest from 3-4:15pm.

Location: Southwest High School is located at 3414 W 47th St, Minneapolis, MN 55410. The facilitator is responsible for arranging their own transportation.

Learning Objectives: The facilitator will strengthen their group facilitation, youth leadership, outreach, communication, and public health skills. The facilitator is encouraged to be creative when designing events and outreach campaigns.

Desired Qualifications: The facilitator should have experience working with teens and knowledge in youth development and adolescent health. Experience with group facilitation is preferred.

Training Opportunities: Facilitator training curriculum and on the job training

Pay: \$10-15/hour depending on experience

Evaluation: The facilitator will have regular supervision and will receive on-going feedback.
