

One Minneapolis Fund Fact Sheet

- Purpose:** Development of diverse leadership and promotion of community engagement among cultural communities in the City of Minneapolis.
- Eligibility:** Non-profit community and cultural organizations located in the City of Minneapolis. Neighborhood Organizations receiving funding from the Community Participation Program are ineligible.
- Collaborations are a high priority for the One Minneapolis Fund.** The lead organization on the project must fit the eligibility standards; collaborative partners do not. We encourage community and cultural organizations to work with Neighborhood Organizations as potential partners in their projects, when appropriate.
- Funding:** Maximum grants of \$15,000 are available for individual projects. Total program funding is \$80,000. The funding for the One Minneapolis Fund comes from the general fund of the City of Minneapolis.
- Application Deadline:** April 7, 2014, 4:00p.m. (CDT)
- Application Process:** Applications are to be submitted to the City of Minneapolis Office of Procurement. The Minneapolis Neighborhood and Community Engagement Commission will review the applications and make funding recommendations to the Minneapolis City Council. Final funding decisions will be made by the City Council. Funding decisions are expected in June 2014 with projects starting shortly after.
