Small Grants Program Neighborhood Priority Plan
Adopted 5/14/2014

The Fulton Neighborhood Association (FNA) proposes to establish and fund a grant program consistent with previously identified NRP strategies. This grant program will financially support a range of activities which will allow further community engagement opportunities in the neighborhood.

FNA will develop grant guidelines for the program that are consistent with its desired outcomes. FNA hopes to address any issues of concern or needs in the neighborhood by assisting with small efforts of our community partners. These efforts will include things such as programming by non-profits for youth and family support, school related support, events that build community, etc.

By providing financial support to organizations also doing work in Fulton neighborhood, FNA will be able to engage different segments of the community and also offer its financial and organizational support. This may offer up further opportunities for FNA to engage residents on other topics, needs or areas of concern in the future; it allows entry into groups or organizations with which we did not previously have a community building relationship.

We propose the use of Neighborhood Priority funds to create this grant program and provide funding of up to \$5,000 per year for several small grants in 2014, 2015 and 2016.
