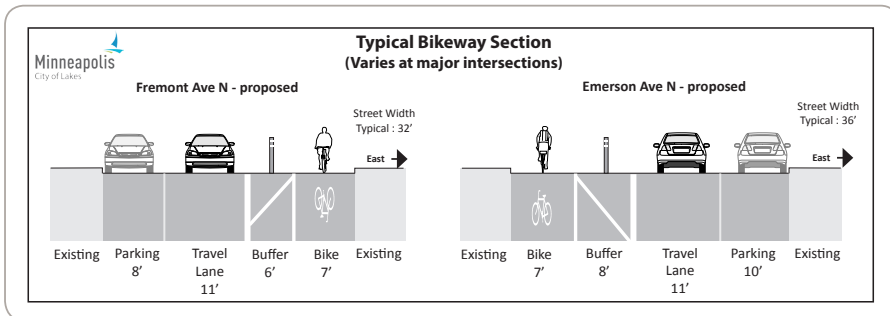

Emerson & Fremont Bicycle & Pedestrian Improvements

The City of Minneapolis Public Works Department is proposing changes to Emerson Ave N and Fremont Ave N in 2018 that are intended to improve the street for biking and walking, and are also expected to help calm traffic along the corridor.

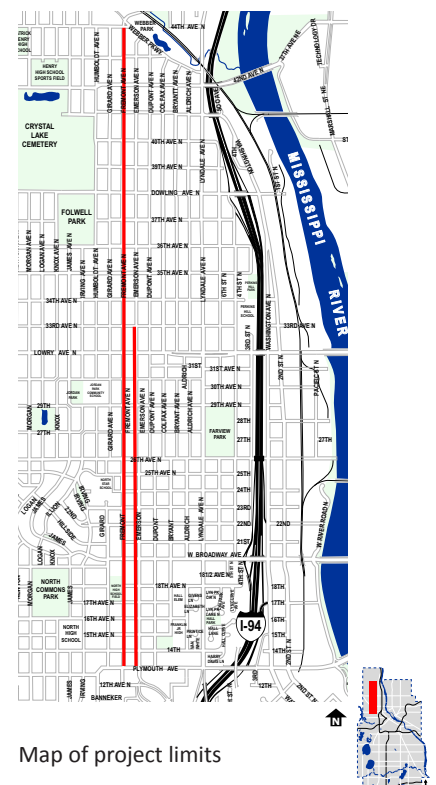
Major project changes:

- A protected bikeway will be installed along Emerson Ave N and Fremont Ave N from Plymouth Ave N to 33rd Ave N
- Pedestrian improvements will be constructed to reduce crossing distances, improve sightlines, and improve ADA accessibility
- One travel lane will be removed from Emerson Ave N to allow for the installation of the protected bikeway
- Parking will change sides of the street on Fremont Ave N from Plymouth to Lowry, and on Emerson Ave N from Plymouth to West Broadway
