

35th St E Reconstruction

Project Fact Sheet

The City of Minneapolis proposes to reconstruct 35th Street East in the area immediate adjacent to the rail crossing just east of Hiawatha Ave. The proposed 250 foot long project is scheduled to occur during the 2019 construction season and will consist of improvements to the roadway, sidewalk and rail crossing. City staff is currently in the preliminary stages of planning and design for the project, which will be accompanied by community outreach activities that will help inform and guide design concepts.

PURPOSE

The scope of the project will encompass the entire right-of-way and will include full removal of the existing street, subgrade correction, new pavement, curb and gutter, driveways, sidewalks and utility work as needed. The project will coordinate with the railroad to improve conditions at the rail crossing.

EXISTING CONDITIONS

The existing right of way is 60 feet wide and the street width is 44 feet from curb to curb. Existing sidewalks are 6.5 feet in width with some obstructions within the pedestrian through walk. Pedestrian ramps are generally not ADA compliant and there is currently no boulevard present. The railroad is active with approximately 16 rail crossings per day. The pavement condition was rated in very poor condition.
