






Project Overview





What is the project?

- 4th St. last reconstructed in 1962
 - Aging infrastructure
 - No longer meets users needs
- 4th St. between 2nd Ave. N. and
 4th Ave. S.
- Reconstruct from building face to building face








Project Purpose


- Replace the aging street infrastructure

- Improve the pedestrian realm by widening sidewalks








Project Schedule

 February 2021 Ongoing


- Phase 1 roadway reconstruction –

Construction Phasing, Impacts and Expectations






Project Phasing



 Landscape plantings and furnishing will be completed the following spring for each phase







Utility Construction

- Private utilities
 - Xcel Energy
 - Private telecommunication companies
- Public utilities
 - Watermain construction
 - Storm sewer construction

*Public utilities will be coordinated with road reconstruction







Roadway Reconstruction


- Roadway reconstruction starting from west to east
- Coordinated intersection work at Hennepin Ave.
- 4th St. closed to through traffic once construction begins
- Local access maintained to driveways
- Pedestrian access maintained
- Vehicle and bus detours





Traffic Detour

- Phase 1: Northbound 2nd Ave. to Eastbound Washington Ave. to Southbound 4th Ave.
- Phase 2: Northbound 2nd Ave. to Eastbound Washington Ave. to Southbound Hennepin Ave.









Bus Relocation

- The existing contraflow bus lane has been removed
- All westbound bus routes have been relocated
 - o Route 3,7, & 14





What to Expect

- Lane and parking restrictions
- Local access to property driveways will be maintained at all times
- Intersections will be maintained
- Noise, vibration, and dust in work areas

WHAT IS HAPPENING

- Starting April 5, roadway reconstruction will begin! There will be additional traffic detours and lane restrictions to facilitate pavement removal between Hennepin Ave. and 3rd Ave. S.
 Some of the trees that are in the way will also be removed.
- During roadway reconstruction, through traffic will be detoured to Washington Ave. and local access will be maintained to driveways. (see 4th St. Construction Newsletter for detour and access maps).
- Xcel Energy utility work will continue between 2nd Ave. S. and 3rd Ave. S. Utility work in this block is anticipated to be complete by mid-June.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- During roadway construction, 4th St. will be closed to through traffic between Hennepin Ave. and 4th Ave. S. Local access to driveways will be maintained during road work.
- During construction work, pedestrian access will be maintained. Be aware of your surrounding when walking on the sidewalk.
- Expect additional noise, dust, and vibration as crews complete work.
