

The Minnesota Agape Movement

On May 26th, 2020, Minnesota Agape Movement emerged as an alternative to Minneapolis Police Department during the unrest following the death of George Floyd. Over the course of thirteen months Agape started off working 24-hour shifts, Minnesota Agape Movement maintained a presence in South Minneapolis and George Floyd Square, building trust within the community and contributing to a significant reduction in crime in Wards 8, 9, 10 and 11. We are proud of the accomplishments of extending the organization beyond patrolling the streets to becoming a rescource hub to meet community needs. Minnesota Agape Movement offers programs (Rites of Passage, Creative Writing, 97 years and counting, Trauma on top of Trauma, Burn bright youth book club) designed to help young people stay safe, reduce violence, and build a culture of respect and understanding. Our team members mentor youth participants, preventing them from entering the schoolto-prison pipeline by visiting Africa to work, protect and love like a village, canvassing the community daily to build relationships with business owners and residents fostering a collective healing, safe, and collaborative enviorment by placing the neighbor back into the hood!

Minnesota Agape Movement Project Idea:


Minnesota Agape Movement (MN Agape) proposes the development of a six-story, multi-purpose facility designed to serve as a cultural, entrepreneurial, and community engagement hub. The proposed building will include the following key components:

- · Ground Floor: A welcoming lobby, café, and retail gift shop.
- Second Floor: A museum dedicated to Civil Resilience, offering a historical and educational exploration of civil unrest and the resilience demonstrated at George Floyd Square.
 - Third Floor: An affordable business incubator to support emerging entrepreneurs and small businesses.
- Fourth Floor: A music and media center, featuring professional recording studios, podcast booths, and a radio station.
 - Fifth Floor: An entertainment venue incorporating a restaurant and bar.
- Sixth Floor: A rooftop garden with a dedicated community event space for gatherings, performances, and civic engagement.






Yaya Cochran






