LETTER OF AGREEMENT

911 Supervisor Training Premium

WHEREAS the City of Minneapolis ("City") and the Law Enforcement Labor Services, Inc., Local No. 564 (Hereinafter "Union") (collectively "the Parties") are parties to a Collective Bargaining Agreement; and

WHEREAS the Union is the exclusive representative for the 911 Supervisor job classification who supervise the 911 Dispatchers in the Minneapolis Emergency Call Center ("MECC");

WHEREAS, both parties desire to establish a training premium for experienced 911 Supervisors to train newly hired 911 Supervisors;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties hereto agree to establish a training premium subject to the following conditions:

- The training premium will be paid at \$3.00 per hour for each hour spent performing training duties.
- An employee that has been designated by the Manager or designee to train another 911 Supervisor shall be eligible for the premium.
- The Employer shall have the exclusive right to designate an employee to be assigned to training duties based on the Employers need.
- The designation to or removal from the training assignment shall not be subject to the grievance procedure.

Either party may terminate this Letter of Agreement with a fourteen (14) day notice of termination.

This Letter of Agreement shall become effective upon ratification of the 2024-2026 collective bargaining agreement.
