

KENWOOD CONCRETE PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The City will improve several streets in the Kenwood neighborhood. The scope of work includes:

- Upgrading many of the pedestrian ramps at the corners
- Enhancing bus stops along the corridor
- Repair of select concrete street panels
- Final diamond grind over the entire roadway

PROJECT GOALS

The Concrete Streets Rehabilitation program extends the life of concrete streets throughout the city.

- To address poor drainage, underlying soil conditions, and higher traffic volumes
- Prolongs the street's life
- Improves ride quality and neighborhood livability


