Project overview

The City will improve four intersections on Lyndale Ave N in north Minneapolis. The goal of these improvements will be to increase traffic safety for all users. This includes car traffic, pedestrians, bicyclists and transit riders. The project will upgrade the traffic signals and ped ramps at each of the four intersections. Other types of safety improvements will also be included. This could include curb extensions, medians, and lighting.

Project goals

- Make signals easier to see and reduce the number of crashes.
- Improve safety and shorten distance of pedestrian crossings.
- Make areas more accessible by adding ADA compliant ramps and APS signals.

Improvement types



The project improvements will upgrade traffic signal infrastructure and make changes to increase the safety of pedestrian crossings. Improvements will include:

- 1. Improved traffic signal visibility
- 2. Curb extensions at some intersection corners (center medians may also be used)
- 3. Accessible Pedestrian Signals (APS)
- 4. ADA-compliant pedestrian curb ramps
- 5. LED Lighting on traffic signal poles
