

Draft Memorial Locations


Note: This draft shows the Flexible-Open concept, however the same locations and space for memorials are also possible in the Transit Mall and Pedestrian Plaza concepts. The final street concept has not yet been determined.

- **A.** Area where George Floyd was murdered: Preserve for future Floyd Family memorial.
- **B. Intersections** leading in and out of the Square and traffic circle: Fist sculpture or new gateways sculptures. (South and east locations not shown.)
- C. People's Way: Whether memorials are located here will be determined with new community centeredowner.
- **D. Flood pond with Say Their Names:** No change currently planned.
- **E. Mourning Passage:** Placeholder. Need to explore artist's intentions for painting vs. permanent.
- F. Gardens: Integrated into the new ROW design.
- **G. Peoples Closet:** The service could be integrated into the new community -center redevelopment of the Peoples Way.
- H. To be determined: Other existing small scale works to be integrated into the new ROW design. (Not shown.)

Roles

Rise and Remember:

 Has done very important work in stewarding and conserving the memorials. The City is communicating with Rise and Remember on planning for the Right of Way and People's Way projects.

City of Minneapolis:

- Work with conservators and artists on reintegrating existing memorials into the Street (ROW) project.
- Plan for and move memorials for construction.
- Review, approve and permit all memorials, both new works and reintegrated works.

Artists:

- Likely own their works at the Square.
- Some will have the opportunity to inform the reintegration of their works into the new Street (ROW) design.
- May remove their works if they decide they do not want them reintegrated.

Conservators:

 The City will hire conservators to meet with artists and community, plan this work, and do conservation as needed.

GFS Caretakers:

• Caretakers working through Rise and Remember at GFS will have the opportunity to inform the planning process.
