



Peoples' Way Technical Study

On June 30, 2023, the City of Minneapolis purchased the Peoples' Way property at 3744 Chicago Ave. The community continues to use the space for gathering.

In preparation for the future Request for Qualifications (RFQ), the City conducted a technical study to identify limitations and opportunities for future development on the site. This study is guided by the design goals and engagement themes from previous workshops and the Design Requirements listed below. A future Community Owner will create the final design for the Peoples' Way.

- The City will incorporate the community's priorities into an RFQ process to select the Community Owner. The RFQ is a way for the City to ask interested groups to apply to the City to become the Community Owner of the site.
- The RFQ will be open for approximately two months.

2025

- City staff will work with community members to recommend one Community Owner to the City Council and the Mayor.
- The Mayor and City Council will make the final selection. The selected Community Owner, community stakeholders, and City staff will work together to shape the future of the site.

- Meet the requirements of the American with Disabilities Act (ADA)







Enhanced Existing Peoples' Way




Low/Medium Density




