Making intersections safer with smarter solutions

Project background

The city will be installing permanent concrete pedestrian refuge medians to:

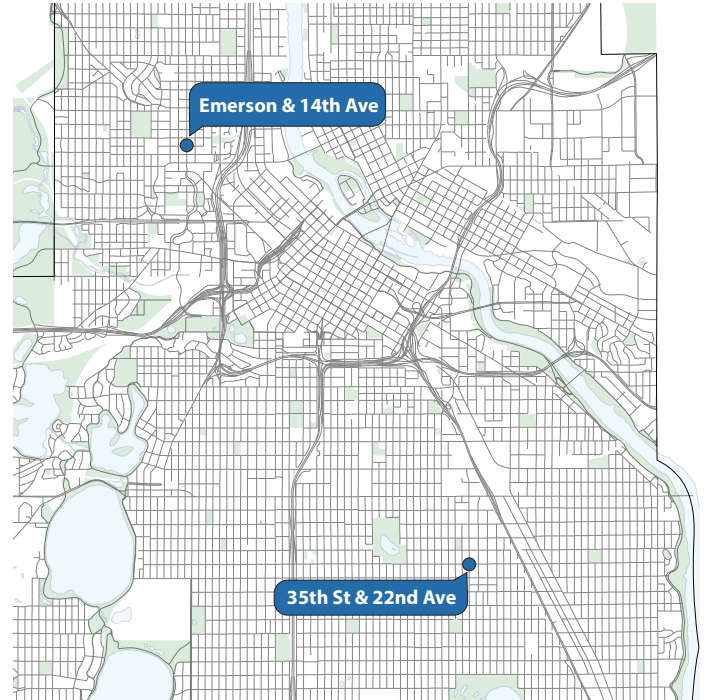
- Allow people walking and rolling to navigate one direction of traffic at a time when crossing
- Create shorter crossing distances for people walking and rolling across the street
- Improve vehicle yielding to those walking and rolling across the street
- Promote safe driving
- Lower vehicle speeds

Project goals

- Make streets safer for all people
- Reduce all crashes on our streets, especially severe and fatal
- Create a more livable, walkable, and safer community for all

Here's what we know

- A small number of our streets (9%) are where the majority (66%) of severe or fatal crashes are happening
- These streets, E 35th St and Emerson Ave N, are identified as high injury streets
- We know that the following people are overrepresented in severe and fatal crashes
 - People walking
 - People rolling
 - Historically marginalized groups
