
# 2025 Traffic Signal Improvements

- LaSalle Ave at 15<sup>th</sup> St
- LaSalle Ave at Grant St
- LaSalle Ave at Groveland Ave
- Willow St at 15<sup>th</sup> St
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave at 18<sup>th</sup> St
- 26<sup>th</sup> St at Emerson Ave
- 26<sup>th</sup> St at Dupont Ave
- 28<sup>th</sup> St at Emerson Ave
- 28<sup>th</sup> St at Dupont Ave

### **Project Highlights**

The Traffic Signal Improvements project will upgrade traffic signal infrastructure and improve the pedestrian space to current standards. The project will include:

- 1. Improved traffic signal visibility
- Curb extensions (also known as curb bump-outs) to expand pedestrian space at select intersection corners
- 3. Accessible Pedestrian Signals (APS)
- 4. Pedestrian curb ramps which comply with the Americans wi
- 5. LED Lighting on traffic signal poles



## **Construction Impacts**

Side street access will be closed for portions of the project to accommodate construction; alternative routes will be provided. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times. Access to all properties will also be maintained. All traffic impacts and parking restrictions will be posted in advance.

#### **Project Schedule**

- In progress: Review by MnDOT.
- Late April 2025: Construction starts.
- October 2026: Construction completion.
