This training assumes you are <u>enrolled in Self-Service Password Reset</u>. It's also recommended that all employees set up the Microsoft Authenticator App. At the City, we use this app to add an extra layer of security to our accounts, including email and OneDrive. 1. From your City computer's login screen, click "Reset password".
