

West Fulton Neighborhood Improvement Project

Project background

The Minneapolis Department of Public Works is planning to make improvements to neighborhood streets in the western section of the Fulton neighborhood. The project area extends from France to Xerxes avenues and from 47th St to 54th St. The project will repair or replace deteriorating pavement, sidewalks where needed, and underground stormwater pipes. It will also include stormwater treatment practices to meet the City's stormwater ordinance, along with making pedestrian and bicycle improvements consistent with adopted city policies. Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) pedestrian ramp upgrade work to begin this year (2025) south of 50th St. Pavement restoration work will begin in 2026 and include ADA pedestrian ramp upgrades.

Project schedule

The planning and public input phase is underway. We anticipate improvements will begin in 2025 and will be phased over the next several years.

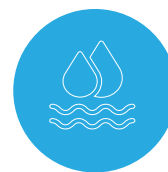
