

SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL

Whittier International Elementary School Phase 2

Project overview

- W. 26th, 27th, and 28th streets between Blaisdell Avenue and Lyndale Avenue S., intersection of E. 26th Street at Stevens Avenue
- Improve comfort and safety for students and children walking and biking near Whittier International Elementary School
- Safety improvements will benefit all street users
- Phase 1 improved the intersections of W. 26th Street at Grand Avenue and W. 27th Street at Blaisdell Avenue in 2022

What we know

- According to the Whittier Safe Routes to School Plan (2017), 15% of students at Whittier Elementary walk or bike to school
- Nicollet Avenue, Blaisdell Avenue, Lyndale Avenue, 26th Street, and 28th Street are high injury streets
- High vehicle speeds and poor visibility create unsafe crossing conditions

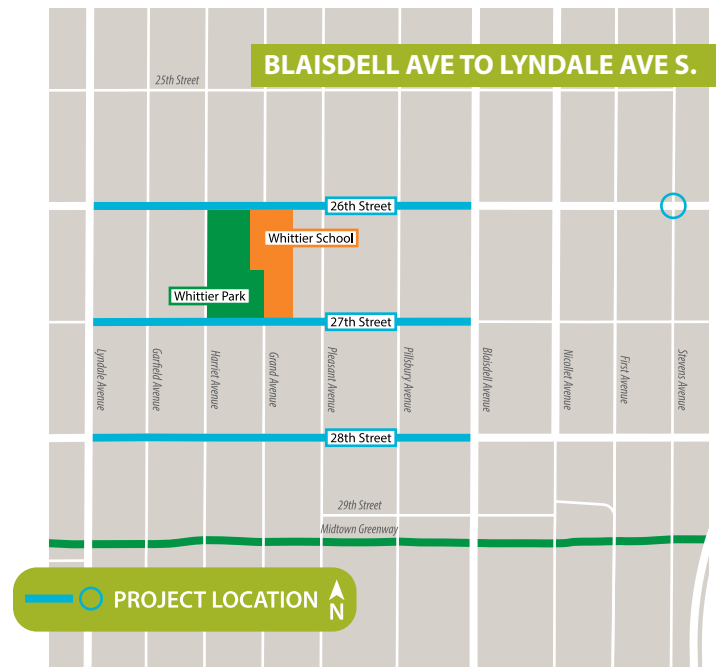

	Bicycle:	11 reported crashes	82% crashes with injuries
	Motor Vehicle:	317 reported crashes	25% crashes with injuries
